The BEARDED COLLIE is a shaggy-appearing, medium-sized dog with a medium-length coat. The outer coat is flat and harsh. The undercoat is soft and furry. The Beardie has a long, lean body, with a bright, inquiring expression in his eyes that is a distinctive feature of the breed.

Beardies can be shades of BLACK, BROWN, FAWN or BLUE (blue-grey), with or without white markings on the face, neck, chest, paws, forelegs, and tip of tail.
